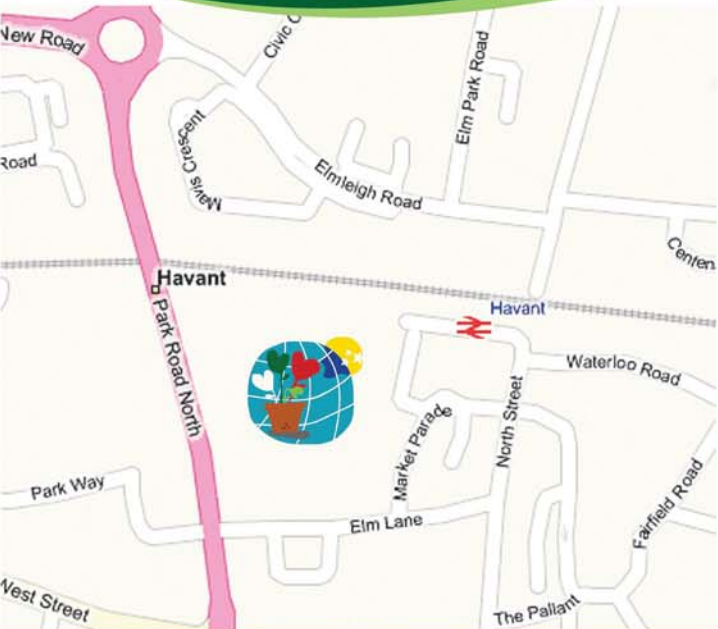

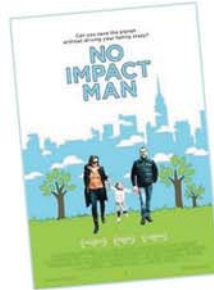
Monday 23rd May
