Saturday 25th April - Sunday 17 May 2015 15:30 Emsworth Artists Follow the 2015 Emsworth Art Trail between Saturday 25 April and Sunday 4th May. The museum component is extended through to Sunday 17th May and may be seen on Saturdays 10.30 to 16.30, Sundays 14.30 to 16.30 and on Monday 4th May 14.30 to 16.30. This year three artists are sharing the David Rudkin Room for the Art Trail. Chris Abel, a fused glass artist, creates an exceptional selection of coastal inspired work using art glass and recycled materials. Carol Millard paints mainly in acrylic - her subjects are varied, whatever she finds interesting at the time - but topiary and portraiture predominate. A fresh face to the event is Eloise Biddlecombe, an illustrator and stitch artist working with textiles, breaking preconceived ideas of what embroidery can be. Many of her projects are based on social commentary but she always maintains a light-hearted approach to her designs.

Both Carol and Eloise are part of the "Adopt an Artist" scheme through which local businesses promote an artist's work. Carol has been adopted by Envisage Dentist and Eloise by "The Corner House". Monty Reed was a keen photographer and some of his photographs showing sports days and events, school and local shows, dinghy sailing and cycling trips to Kingley Vale feature in the exhibition. Mr Reed served in the Royal Navy during WW II, spending some of the time on HMS Bullfrog. While he was away, his mother and some pupils' parents kept in touch, and a selection of this correspondence will be displayed.
