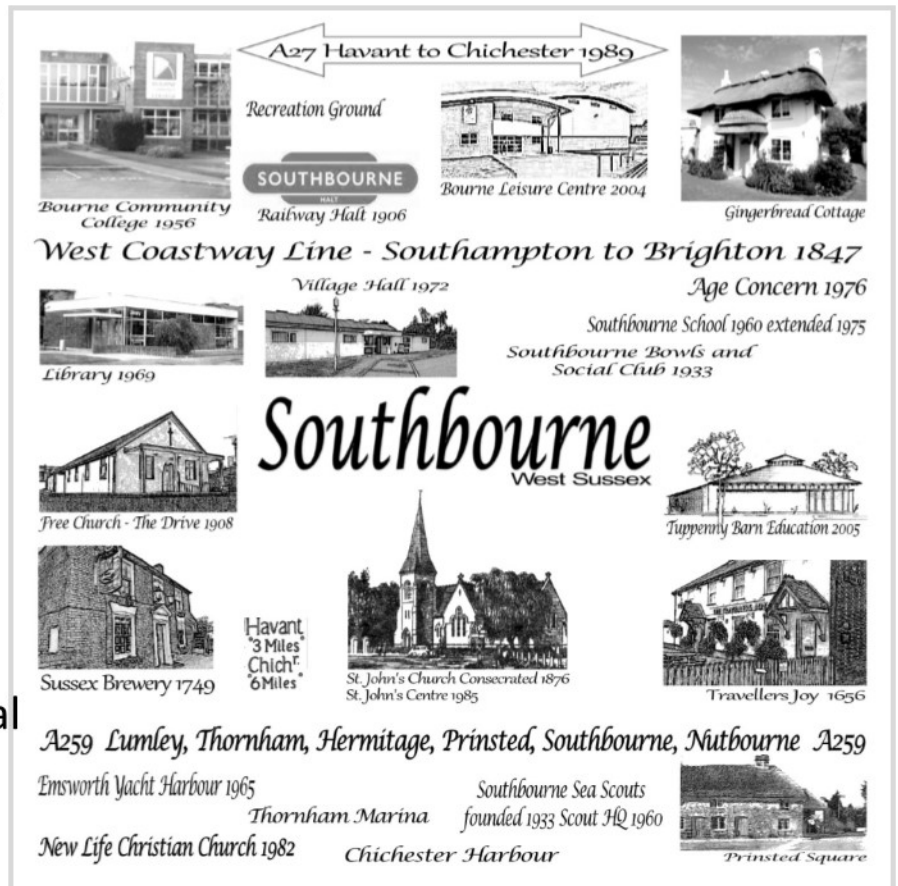

The elementary education act of the 1870's affected our old school in Stein Road (where the Social Club is) and in 1876 it changed from Prinsted Board School to Southbourne Council School. St John's Church was consecrated on 18th May 1876 but remained part of Westbourne Parish until the first vicar, Rev Holloway was inducted in 1878 and the Southbourne Ecclesiastical Parish formed.

The Emsworth boundary is the western bank of Hermitage Bridge. Thorney Road, Emsworth Marina, Slipper and Lumley are all in Southbourne.
