As you enjoy walking around the village you will find work by various local artists displayed in shops and businesses - they are listed overleaf.

Ten artists have kindly opened their doors to display work in their studios and homes—a unique chance to see where some of their work was created, meet with them and gain an insight into their sources of inspiration.

The Arts Trail Exhibition is in the Community Centre in Church Path. Twenty artists and crafts people will be showing the wide range of work being made in Emsworth. Some of the artists will be on hand to talk about their work and there will be refreshments available. Admission is free, and work is for sale.

Why not also take this opportunity to see the Millennium Map in Emsworth Museum?

A joint effort by a number of Emsworth's artists, it portrays the town in a unique and fascinating manner. The map is only viewable and purchasable from the Museum, which also has an extensive display on the town's history, its seafaring and trading families. There is also a special section devoted to P.G. Wodehouse, who lived and wrote in Emsworth.

The Museum also holds a collection of Emsworth art over the centuries, which includes many internationally known artists, such as Richard Joyce.

A whole park full of fun - A great afternoon out for all the family



### 1. Pippa Blake - 3 Western Parade

Pippa's paintings of industrial landscapes have been exhibited widely. She is interested in relationships of colour and form, and the paring down of subject matter.

### 2. Judy Glanville - 46 Warblington Road

Judy is a potter who studied in London & Southampton

### 3. Bobbie Bale - 45 Warblington Road

Bobbie has painted all her life. Her work on display is influenced by living in the Middle East and New Zealand, her love of the English countryside and similarities and contrasts.

### 8. Helena Hines - 35 Park Crescent


Helena has exhibited widely will be showing work in various media on 'Land, Sea & People'
