Dark skies are one of the most amazing things about the South Downs National Park. It's incredible to have this haven for stargazing in the busy south-east, giving easy access for all to enjoy connecting with the dark, star-filled universe around us. To celebrate our 10th anniversary join 11 days of exploring the dark skies of the South Downs and the nocturnal wildlife that lives here. You can:

- ★ Discover the National Park through night walks and meet local astronomy groups.
- ★ Join star parties at Seven Sisters and Queen Elizabeth Country Parks, Amberley Museum, Alice Holt Forest and on Brighton seafront.
- ★ Discover our new family-friendly Dark Skies Explorer Trail to listen to the story of the Great Bear.
- ★ Find out about nocturnal wildlife and learn about biofluorescence (things that shine under UV light!).
- ★ Listen to stories of the stars above us.
- ★ Explore our 'Embrace the Darkness' podcast, all about nocturnal wildlife, and take part in some recording.
- ★ Scan the QR code to check out our new Dark Skies Hub to view prize-winning astrophotography and details of extra festival events.
- ★ Explore our 10 Dark Sky Discovery sites through short films before visiting in-person.


**18:30 Alice Holt Night Walk


