local nature reserve and haven for
wildlife near Emsworth town centre.

the River Ems in the west and
Lumley Road in the east and many

The Brook Meadow Conservation Group was formed in 2000 by local residents to restore, protect and conserve the natural environment of the meadow for the benefit and quiet enjoyment of the general public.
